Communication, utterance - pragmalinguistic perspective

Abstract: Communication is a very broad area of research, which can be tackled under various aspects. Our research aims at analyzing and interpreting language facts from a pragmalinguistic perspective, focusing on actors, in particular the journalist-sender and the reader-receiver. Pragmalinguistics, linguistic pragmatics or pragmatics "are primarily interested in the elements in the language that fail to convey the complete information if the context in which they are used is not known" (Costăchescu 2019: 2) Communication is thus treated depending on the context in which it occurs.

We cannot talk about the context of communication without referring to the other components of this complex process. Roman Jakobson "distinguishes six constituent factors: sender, receiver, message, context, code, contact" (DSL 2001: 126.). Starting from the factors of communication, we have shown that utterance represents the way in which the speaker individualizes the linguistic code in the act of communication. In a synthetic perspective, we retrieved the various definitions of the term, but we also discussed the notions of "utterance" and "phrase", highlighting the differences that specialists pointed out regarding these "entities". We have referred to the phenomenon of polyphony in utterance, presenting both Ducrot's theory and its Scandinavian version, known as ScaPoLine and enounced mainly by Henning Nølke. We then broadly discussed the defining elements of the utterance in Oswald Ducrot's view: deictic terms, utterance adverbs, exclamations, or delocutive derivation.
